






FIGURE 1 is a perspective of a desk top manual card reader showing my new design;

FIGURE 2 is a front elevation of the reader of FIG-URE 1;

FIGURE 3 is a side elevation of the reader of FIG-URE 1 taken from the right side thereof.

The side of the machine not shown is substantially a mirror image of the side shown except for the omission of the control handle, while the rear of the machine, not shown, is substantially plain and unornamented.
